GUEST CONDUCTORS



JOHN NESS BECK, a native of Ohio, received Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in music from Ohio State University where he became a member of the faculty. His creative talents have made him one of the most popular composers with an extensive list of anthems which are widely acclaimed. In partnership with a friend, Mr. Beck formed Beckenhurst Press, a publishing house

which encourages new talents and also promotes Beck's compositions. He served as choir director of the University Baptist Church in Columbus, Ohio. He is in great demand for appearances as a lecturer and guest conductor at clinics and festivals throughout the country.



ARTHUR W. CROUTHAMEL won the coveted Philadelphia Board of Education Music Scholarship and earned both Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Music Supervision at Temple University. He studied choral conducting with Elaine Brown, famed conductor of the "Singing City Choir." His organ studies were with Dr. Harry C. Banks at Girard College. After having taught music

in the Abington School District, Mr. Crouthamel became the Principal of Pennridge Central Junior High School, Perkasie, Pa. He serves as Organist and Music Director of Christ Reformed Church at Indian Creek, Telford, Pa. He is the founder and Musical Director of the Abington Oratorio Choir, a concert ensemble of seventy-five voices.



JESTER HAIRSTON is a graduate of Tufts University, Boston, where he majored in music. He has been an actor on radio, television, and in films. Dr. Hairston is a composer, conductor and arranger who is dedicated to preserving the marvelous heritage of black spiritual music. Numerous times he has been sent abroad by the United States State Department as an Ambassador of

Good Will to teach Afro-American folk songs. He conducts clinics and concerts in universities, in churches, in European cathedrals and recently with the Mormon Tabernacle Choir.



ROSS HASTINGS was born in Los Angeles where he grew up surrounded by major musical events since his father was organist of the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra and the Zemple Baptist Church, and the Temple Baptist Church. He attended the University of Southern California. He became choral conductor and orchestrator for the San Diego Symphony under Dr. Fabien Sevitzky. Mr. Hastings was

staff arranger for the Hollywood Bowl. After moving to New York he became Editor-in-Chief for Warner Bros. Publications and later held the same position at Bourne Co., a major music publisher. He now devotes full time to composition.



HIRAM HERSEY, a Graduate of Westminster Choir College, has studied at Union Theological Seminary, School of Sacred Music, and the Hochschule für Musik in West Berlin. He has also studied privately with Julius Hestford, Sergio Kopin and William Smith. He has been director of the Frampton and Lancaster Choral Groups for the past 32 years. Mr. Hershey is a

summer resident of Ocean Grove and former Chairman of the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts. Groups from the Franconia and Lancaster Choral Groups have made three trips to sing in churches in the Soviet Union.



ROBERT IVEY is Minister of Music at the First Presbyterian Church, Red Bank, N. J., where he supervises a program of nine singing groups and five handbell groups. Mr. Ivey is known nationally as an authority on handbell ringing and has served for twelve years on the Board of Directors of the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers, Inc., during which time he served a two

year term as President. Beginning September 1st Mr. Ivey will assume the position of Minister of Music at the First Presbyterian Church, Charlotte, North Carolina.



MR. WILLIAM E. SHOPPELL, JR. is a graduate of Lebanon Valley College and Columbia University, is Music Director and Conductor of the Monmouth Civic Chorus. Under his leadership this superb choral organization has gained recognition for its high standards of performance with full orchestral accompaniments. Mr. Shoppell is Chairman of the Music Department of the Free-

hold Regional High School District and has served as choir director in area churches.

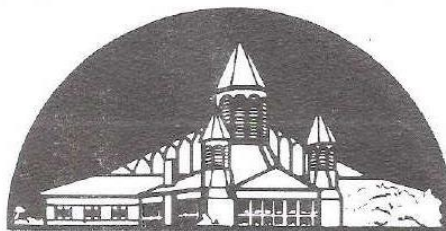
